

RIDE VIRGINIA Annual Poker Run May 31st, 2025

Join us for the 17th RIDE VIRGINIA Poker Run on May 31, 2025, benefiting the Greater Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity. The event starts at 9:00 am at the GFHFH ReStore and ends at Gourmeltz, where poker hands must be submitted by 1:30 pm to win prizes of \$250 for the best and worst hands.







A 50/50 raffle will also take place, with tickets priced at \$5. Participants will receive a poker hand, an event T-shirt (while supplies last), a Gourmeltz coupon, and a door prize ticket.
